

# Ontario long-term care transitions during COVID-19

Have you or a family member left, or considered leaving a long-term care home during the COVID-19 pandemic?

OR

Have you provided transition support to residents and families leaving long-term care homes during the COVID-19 pandemic?

We are conducting a study on care transitions from long-term care homes in Ontario during the COVID-19 pandemic.

In this study, we will speak with people in Ontario who **experienced, considered, or supported a transition out of a long-term care home** any time since March 2020.

Participants will be invited to one 30- to 60-minute phone or Zoom interview, where they will be asked to share their experience and perspective on care transitions from long-term care homes during the COVID-19 pandemic.

**You may be eligible to participate if you are either:**

**A**

An **older adult** (65+ years old) who lives, or lived, in a long-term care home during the pandemic.

**B**

A **family member or friend** who supports an older adult who lives, or lived in a long-term care home during the pandemic.

**C**

A **care provider** who offers transition support to residents and families in long-term care homes.
